Project Summary

To repair/improve drainage on existing kennels the rescued dogs and cats of DrowzyDawg Rescue so that more animals can be saved and assisted to a new permanent home.

Project Evaluation

Our original plan to elevate pens on decking was thwarted by increasing lumber prices. Cook's Landscaping developed a plan to grade the area, and build up the slope with cement blocks. They installed a drain on the north end then brought the entire kennel area to level with the road base. Six inches of crushed granite was applied on top of the road base to provide easier cleaning and sanitation. The pens were secured to the cement blocks and ground with rebar and cement. They were covered with heavy duty tarps to provide protection from the elements.

We purchased four door panels and this allowed us to convert a 40-foot pen to four 10 by 10 pens with the option of opening gates between pens to increase size as needed.
